

## **Lead the Future: NCCPA Director at Large Opportunity**

The NCCPA is seeking one Board Certified PA member at large to begin serving on the NCCPA Board beginning in January 2027. Board members are elected for a four-year term and are eligible for re-election for a second four-year term.

The NCCPA Board meets in person four times a year for two full days and provides strategic direction and oversight for the organization in fulfillment of directors' fiduciary obligations to NCCPA, working closely with the President/CEO. Board members typically serve on two or three committees or task forces in any given year, which generally conduct their work via video conference call, email, and in-person committee meetings that are scheduled during the Board Meeting. Committee assignments are reviewed and selected each year and will vary across Board service.

While members of our volunteer Board of Directors do not receive any remuneration for their service, NCCPA does cover all travel expenses, lodging, and meals for meetings of the Board and committees.

To balance the current composition of the Board and broaden the range of perspectives represented there, the ideal PA Director-At-Large candidate will demonstrate several of the following characteristics, however these are not a requirement for consideration:

- Practices in the Midwest or Western United States
- Has experience working with the medically underserved, in the Indian Health System, or in a Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHC)
- Preferably practices clinically in a rural or other non-urban region
- Has experience practicing internationally (outside of the US)
- Practices in the specialty area of behavioral health or oncology
- Holds a Certificate of Added Qualifications (CAQ) from NCCPA

All candidates should be able to plan strategically and long-term and bring a commitment to NCCPA's mission. Prior experience on a nonprofit board is beneficial but not required.
